As General Manager of the ISCA, Bob has the experience to back up his decisions. He started judging ISCA shows in the early 70's quickly becoming an ISCA supervisor in 1973.

In 1979, Bob became ISCA, Competitive Director and also met Sandy, the woman who would become his wife. Of course Sandy was heavily involved in the ISCA as the Southeastern Division Director. Leave it to Bob to find the prettiest and sweetest woman in the ISCA. Bob and Sandy married in 1983.

Over the years, Bob has judged hundreds of car shows. Along the way, he has become the goodwill ambassador for our sport. His gregarious nature naturally bonds with competitors, sponsors and his peers.

Bob has received countless honors, attesting to his stronghold in this business. SEMA named him "individual of the Year," in 2010. In 2013: The National Street Rod Association (NSRA) honored Bob with an Achievement Award for his contributions to the industry.

His involvement with the Ridler Award has been a key factor in the evolution of the competition. Bob first worked with Al Maynard in the early years and then Butch Patrico for the last 15 years to help raise the Ridler Award to "brass ring" status.

Bob's Love of this sport is ever-present, therefore he was the perfect candidate to develop our youth initiative, which has become a thriving program.

As much as Bob loves cars, there is no greater love than the love of a child. One of Bob's proudest accomplishments is imparting his love of car shows onto his son, Brian, who is one of the top ISCA officials today.


