Meeting Minutes – December 2



Doug Rodgers called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm. He was filling in for Pat who has been in the hospital for the last 5 days. He welcomed the 13 members in attendance. Prayer requests were asked for. Bob Latham led the Pledge of Allegiance and gave the opening prayer.

Bob provided the Treasurer's report: Beginning Balance: \$16,614.29, Activity: \$-8,243.32. Ending Balance: \$8,370.97. The large outflow were our contributions written to our local organizations. They are complete for 2025. Jackie made a motion to accept the report. Seconded by Chris G. Motion passed.

The minutes from the last meeting were published in the newsletter. Thanks to Ashley for capturing these notes. Sherri made a motion to accept the minutes as published. Rob Seconded. Motion passed.

Old Business began with a discussion on our 2025 car shows. Doug commented that both 2025 shows went well. He wants to begin the work on the 2026 shows in January. Selling Program Book advertisements will be the first activity as they need to be forwarded to Pat for layout in March. Linda asked about assigning sponsors to members. Rick E. has developed a spreadsheet, using our 2025 program book, which can be used to organize that. He will forward it to Doug.

Membership is currently at 43 members. Doug stated the next goal will be 60 members. All dues are due at the next meeting on January 6th. Please pay promptly. Rick E. emailed letters to our active member list today as a reminder. He has a second letter written to send to 130 former members. Our membership roster has been updated from the actual forms for 2022 through 2024 (3 years). Bobby Estes presented an idea to make membership free to all who attend every meeting, but added this may be hard to verify.

While Bobby had the floor he mentioned that he was working on the Lakeway Power Tour schedule for 2026. The very first event will be on January 1st to the Random Rods Cruise In at Subway in Rogersville. Meet at the Shell station across the bridge in Bean Station at 8:00 am to caravan together. We will park in the Burger King next to Subway.

We will deliver the toys we collected at our "Fill the Truck with Toys" car show to the Jefferson City Chamber of Commerce at the Armory on Old AJ Highway in Jefferson City at 9:00 am on Friday, December 5th. Please come out if you want to help.

The Mustang Club will hold a Christmas Party Tuesday, December 9th at the Golden Corral in Morristown at 7:00 pm. Please bring a new unwrapped toy for Toys for Tots. A few door prizes will be given to attendees. The Club meeting will commence at 7:30 pm.

New business began with Rick E. reviewing some of the major by-law changes that are forthcoming. The number of Board of Director (BOD) members and committee structure were briefly discussed. We must always have an odd number of BOD members, which include the President and Past President. Currently, our Past President is inactive, thus we need an additional member. Linda made a motion for Rick E. to fill that position. Rick accepted. Bobby E. seconded the motion. Motion passed. Two new articles have been drafted to outline our process for giving to charitable organizations. These have not yet been approved by the BOD. The current by-laws, published on our website, are still in effect.

By-Laws Update

The MCC Car Club By-laws is a “living” document that outlines the constitution and administration of the club. Being a living document, it must be consistently updated to ensure that they represent guidelines for how the club operates (saying what we do) and auditing that club leaders are working within those guidelines (doing what we say). Changes were recognized in the existing document, and a new draft was created.

The Board of Directors met on Tuesday, November 25 to review the changes against the current document and the new draft. This article reviews some of the changes.

- Members. We added member statuses and a new section for removing an active member.
- Board of Directors. The number of BOD members and the role of the President as part of the board were discussed. The total number of BOD members, including the President and Past President, must be odd. Because it is not currently, one additional director will be added immediately. The President has the same rights as other BOD members.
- Election Process. All Board of Director, Club Officers, and Committee Leaders are nominated and elected. There are none appointed. Processes for all three levels were discussed and updated.
- Duties of stated roles were discussed and updated.
 - The Charities Committee was eliminated. Two new by-laws articles states the charitable giving process to organizations and another to individuals and families.
 - The Public Relations position was put under communications.
 - A new Events Committee to manage cruise in production and fun runs was added.
- Many minor changes eliminating redundancy and making the document more readable.

A follow-up meeting of the Board of Directors will take place to complete the review of Articles Seven through Eleven. Once completed, it will be presented to Club Officers and then later to the members. These changes were approved and will go into effect immediately once approved by the membership. The completed 2026 document will be posted publicly on our web site.



In our current by-laws, Article 6, Section 2 - Nominations & Election for Operating Committee Leaders states:

This should occur as soon as possible in the new year, preferably January. Article 7 goes on to provide a brief job description for each committee.

As we are quickly approaching the new year, it is time to find and nominate strong team leaders for these committees. This is a short window of opportunity for change. We are asking every member to do one of two things:

1. To directly step up and volunteer to run a committee, or
2. Volunteer to work on a committee (but not be the leader).

Most roles do not take more than a few hours per month and do not require special skills. All however require a commitment to attend meetings and do the work. Operating expenses, if any, will be reimbursed by the club.

This club has been operating understaffed with only a few individuals shouldering most of the work. It is time to stop that and staff to required levels, or change the club by-laws requiring those levels. It can be argued that if the position has gone unstaffed, then it must not be that important.

One of the many outcomes of volunteering with the Mossy Creek Cruzers Car Club is strengthening your connection to the community, allowing you to make a tangible, positive difference and feel a stronger sense of belonging. 

