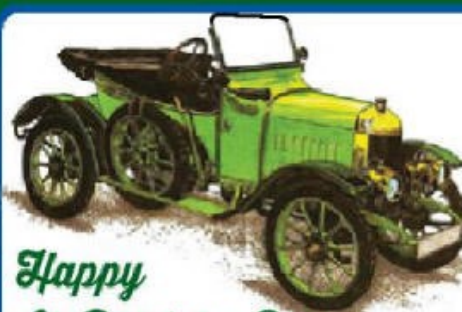

We were greeted by Tina, who gave us a history of when Rob started the business in 1982, in California, and how they ended up in Dandridge. Their specialty is building performance chassis and suspension parts for resto mods (especially late 40s-mid 70s trucks and Tri-Five Chevys) and gassers. They also manufacture custom fuel tanks. In addition, they are distributors for Ididit, Painless Wiring, Wilwood brake components, Curry parts, etc.

The group was then introduced to Rob, who gave us a tour of the shop, where we saw, first hand, how these products are manufactured. He also has a couple of projects, in-house, that they are working on. One is for a friend. It is a second-generation Camaro race car with complete custom frame and roll cage. Another is Rob's project – an early 50s Ford cab-over, slant-bed tow truck, which required some innovative engineering. Rob is an extremely talented automotive engineer and an artist at his craft.

At the conclusion of our tour, we went back into the showroom, where Tina gave us each a choice of a hat or T-shirt.
