



### Easy 3 Ingredient No Bake Pudding Cake

#### **INGREDIENTS**

- 3 small (4 serving size) packages instant pudding.
  - Prepared as directed (6 cups)
- 8 oz cool whip thawed
- 1 Box graham crackers

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Lay out graham crackers in a 9" x 13" pan
- 2. Cover graham crackers with half of the pudding
- 3. Layer graham crackers over the pudding layer
- 4. Cover graham cracker layer with remaining pudding
- 5. Top with cool whip
- 6. Refrigerate overnight or for at least 6 hours
- 7. Cut & serve like cake
