### AUGUST 24th CAR SHOW to be held at Bush's Visitor Center

We will again be at Bush's Visitor Center. This year we will be behind the parking lot in the horse arena and the ball park where there is lots of room! It is August 24th from 9 am to 3 pm. The area is spread out so we will need lots of volunteers to help by working in the parking area and in the registration booth. It will be a little closer parking than last year. Spaces are 12' wide by 22' long.

We also need volunteers to help with the door prizes. A car show committee has been organized and certain areas assigned to volunteers to get donations from. That way we won't be going to the same place twice. Hopefully a lot of you will volunteer for this, the more help we get, the less each of us will have to do! We need people to volunteer to get door prizes from the Morristown, Dandridge, Newport and Kodak areas. Please let Bud Morello or Glenn Allred know if you can do this for the club.

Plan, if you can, to come to the horse arena and ball park on *Friday*, *August 23rd* and possibly *Thursday*, *August 22nd* to get the area ready and decide where the vehicles will go and where the food vendors and swap meet will be. Last year we had a great turnout for this and we hope we will have that many or more again this year. Anything that we need to take, ie: tables, chairs, tents, etc to the area before the show can be brought on Friday the 23rd. That way we can all drive our classic cars on the day of the show. On April 13th a pancake breakfast will be held at the Dandridge Lions Club from 7 am to 10 am. Rogersville is having a car show at the City Park on April 6th. Proceeds go to the Relay for Life.

Pat said J.D. Cable (entertainer that is coming to the Bush show) and Rich Johnson (Rich Leather Motorcycle Shop) contacted Pat about a car show, motorcycle show and entertainment festival that they would like us to join them in. Pat told them they need to find a venue first and then set a meeting with Bud, Larry, Glenn and Pat about it. It could prove to be a huge event.

Sharon McCaulley, our Events Director, has scheduled us to go to the Cruise Against Cancer event in Newport together. Meet at 8am at First Peoples Bank in Dandridge to leave at 8:30.



# Celebrate Life Cancer Support Group

Our guest speaker at the April meeting is the founder of this group. It was started in 1999 by Michele Sexton, a Breast Cancer survivor. They are a non-profit group that depends solely on donations to keep the good work going. MCC Charitiy Committee, Michelle Tipton, invited her to come to the meeting and tell us about the charity.

New-On-cologist, a dietician, a social worker, a coun-

selor and many more, speak at these meetings.

Celebrate Life provides donated items such as wigs, turbans, walkers and other aids for patients use. They also provide snacks for patients at two Morristown cancer treatment centers' and one cancer center in Sevierville.

They receive grant money, donations and have fund raisers such as the Cruise Against Cancer to raise money to aid patients of all types of cancer. The Hard Times Street Rod Club in Newport is a sponsor and the Cruise Against Cancer on Saturday, April 27th donates all of their proceeds to this cause.

The support group has also participated in the "Relay for Life" sponsored by the American Cancer Society and the "Race for the Cure" put on by the Susan G. Komen Foundation.

The Celebrate Life Cancer Support Group focuses on patients in Cocke, Jefferson and Sevier counties and brings snacks to the cancer centers in Morristown. All grant money and donations are used for transportation costs, medicine, supplies, utility bills and any other special needs a patient might have during cancer treatments.

This charity does not take the place of the toys and the Cop shopping that we donated to last year. It is in addition to those charities.
