June 2015 Minutes

The June 2nd meeting of the Mossy Creek Cruzers Car Club was held, as usual, at Shoney's in Dandridge. We had three special guests at the meeting. Skylar Hamilton and his parents attended. Skylar is the Bass Professional Champion in the Pro Master Open and is the youngest champion in the world at 20 years old. He is coming to our July 11th show and is bringing his boat.

In an eight hour tournament, you can catch as many as you want but can only bring in five. In a three day tournament, you can bring in the 15 largest ones that you caught. He fished 280 days last year. We asked what was his favorite fish to fish for besides bass and he said carp!! Skylar said that last year he took Wyatt Crippen, the young man that we helped last year that has a brian tumor, out in a young persons fishing tournament and Wyatt won! He said that was one of the highlights of his career.

On June 6, 1933, Richard Hollingshead, Jr. opened the world's first drive-in movie theater on Crescent Boulevard in Camden, New Jersey. Admission was 25 cents for the car, 25 cents per person and the maximum charge per car was one dollar.

The drive-in's peak popularity came in the late 1950s and early 1960s, with some 4,000 drive-ins across the United States, and more than 40 such theaters in New Jersey alone. Today there remain fewer than 400 operating drive-in theaters nationwide, and sadly, the state where the concept was created has only one remaining in operation.
