The Mossy Creek Cruzers Car Club are proud to have presented two scholarships to Jefferson County High School this year. The two students, Jonathon Anderson and Zeke Bradley, were the recipients. Since we are a car club, we are very interested in keeping the youth of today interested in vehicles, maintenance and the antique and classic vehicles, thus our reasoning for having this Junior car club.

In late 2014, the Cruzers started Mossy Creek Cruzers Junior Car Club at the High School under the guidance of teachers Scott Noe and Carl Crigger, who are the Auto Mechanics teachers. To be in the club the student must be taking auto mechanics classes. The members have to maintain good grades and attendance and they have certain By-Laws set up for their club. The club meets the first Tuesday of each month, during school term, at 3:30 to discuss events and discussions about the club and what it means to be a member and to help their community.

On July 8th, the original Mossy Creek Cruzers Car Club, presents their 7th annual car show at Jefferson Middle School, on Highway 11-E in Jefferson City, from 9:00 am until 3:00 pm. This is the major car show of the year and the charities that are supported are local Special Olympics, Jefferson County Volunteer Fire Departments, Rescue Squad and the scholarships that they give to students from Jefferson County High School. Other charities throughout the year benefit from the charity fund of the club.

Fifties and sixties music will be played during the day by the Open Range Band and lots of activities including 50-50 tickets, cake walks, piston toss, silent auction, fan belt toss, poker walks and guess how many pieces of candy in a jar. There will be barbeque and hamburgers, hot dogs and pinto beans & combread available for purchase, so come hungry and support our vendors.

For the second year, in conjunction to the car show, a craft show will be produced. Come and see the handmade items as well as direct sale items. We hope to make the craft show larger and better each year for the entertainment of the spectators as well as the car vendors. For more info call Pat at the phone number below.

The Cruzers will host another car show on August 26th called Fill the Truck with Toys. The fee to register a vehicle into this show is to bring a new, unwrapped toy to donate. These toys are then donated to Christmas in Jefferson County who gives toys to underprivileged children who otherwise would not have a Christmas gift. It will be held at Bush's Visitor Center in Chestnut Hill from 10:00 am until 3:00 pm.

The Mossy Creek Cruzers Car Club meets the first Tuesday of each month at Shoneys in Dandridge at 7 pm and they host the cruise-in at Big Lots in Jefferson City every Friday evening from 5:30 until 8:30, April until October. The July meeting will be changed to July 5th because of the 4th being on Tuesday.
