
FUN-RUN FEBRUARY 16TH WITH THE HAMBLEN COUNTY CAR CLUB!!

Meeting held at Shoney's in Dandridge - February 5th, 2013

Attended by 44 members and 2 guest.

Gene Honeycutt said a prayer before the beginning of the meeting.

The meeting was started by President Larry Boggess. He welcomed our guest, and new members of which we had several attending for the first time.

Pat Dukes read the minutes from the January meeting. Motion to accept was by Bill O'Connor and the second came from Butch Grooms. Accepted by all.

The January financial report was given by Gene Honeycutt and had a motion to accept by June Howerton. Accepted by all.

OLD BUSINESS:

Glen said he had the club T-shirts with him and that if anyone did not have theirs to meet him just after the meeting at his car.

Larry stated that he had talked with Bud Morello and he will be over the car show this year. Glenn Allred and others said they would help. Bud will be back in Tennessee in March and will then assume responsibilities. Meanwhile a place to have the show is being discussed.

NEW BUSINESS:

Lots of discussions about the car show for this year, with some wanting to stay at Bush's and some wanting to use the Jefferson County High School or the Magnavox parking lot which both have lots of room for expansion. The spaces at the high school were counted and there are just over 500 spaces and it is all paved.

On February 4th Larry, Glenn and Pat met with Max Fultz, a Mossy Creek Cruzers member, from Bush's Visitor Center. He stated that we can have the car show back in the horse arena and the ball field which we estimated would hold around 300 to 350 cars. It is not paved but is covered with a substance that is quick dry. Bush's would furnish the space, electricity, the sound system and would again buy the dash plaques so those things would be no cost to the club. The judging would be up to the club this time and we could have live music if we want it and food vendors and other vendors.

A meeting is to be set up with Jefferson County High School to see if it will be available on August 24th in case we decide to go there for the show. We also need to see what they will allow us to do as far as vendors, and live music. We would have to pay for everything, including port a-potties if it is done here. Also we would have to pay for the dash plaques which ran about \$275 last year and all of the expense on the awards, whether it is photos again or trophies and a sound system. But the potential for growth is here and could include crafts and swap meets which we could charge for the spaces and there is room for everything.

Miller's Creek was mentioned but is very small and would have no spectator parking. The field behind it may belong to Miller's Creek but has no easy access.


Magnavox parking has a lot of space and a line of trees for shade. It is a great space and will hold a lot of cars and vendors etc. A meeting will be held with them to see if it is available.

Members need to attend the March meeting to help decide where they want the show to be. A silent vote by ballot will be held during the meeting.

Gene Honeycutt stated that the Hamblen County Car Club has invited the Cruzers to attend a fun-run with them on Saturday, February 16th to go to the Sweettooth Cafe in Rogersville. Gene needs to know ahead of time if you are attending because they have to make reservations. Call Gene (his number is in the officers list). They will meet at Ingles. Big Lots on the east end of Morristown leaving at 2:00 pm.

The Board of Directors had their first meeting on February 1st with President Larry Boggess and four of the directors attending, Phil Hackman, Bill Potts, Butch Grooms and June Howerton. They studied the Hamblen County Car Club By-Laws and may incorporate some of them into our By-Laws. The major change so far is the change of the wording from Executive Committee to Board of Directors. They suggested that we set up a call system between the members so a "phone tree" of members can be put out. That way one member calls someone and then that person calls someone else so we can get the word out about activities instead of one person having to call everyone.

Suggestions were made to have music at our cruise-ins. A sound system would have to be bought. Gene said he knew of a sound system and will check on the price. Then someone would have to be in charge of the system and make sure it was at the cruise-in each time.



June Howerton had talked to the Memories Theatre in Pigeon Forge about us having a fun-run there. If 30 or more Cruzers came, the price for the show would be \$16 each and anything under the 30 individual members would be \$18 for the show. It is a real good show with impersonators of celebrities and is very entertaining. They would reserve spaces for us.
