

ALWAYS TRY IT BEFORE YOU BUY IT

All too often most people find themselves rushing into a project before properly researching it and this often tends to leave one disappointed at the end of the day, or in most cases with an unfinished project. This post attempts to help you chose which project you would like to build before you go and buy it.

That aside whether it be fiberglass, an old wreck in need of desperate restoration, or if you one of the lucky ones, a rare garage/barn find, here are a few things to bear in mind before you commit yourself to a project.

Never commit yourself to a car until you have fully inspected it (that means look underneath the car as well). All too often people find themselves with much more work on their hands than what they originally thought they had.

Don't be afraid to ask the seller questions. If you feel you have a question that you would like an answer to whether its stupid or not, ask it.

Make sure you can actually do what is required. People often find themselves buying cars with bent chassis that they can't fix themselves and as a result have to pay someone else to fix it for them.

Make sure that it's definitely what you want. Don't just buy it because there's nothing else available, and a week later something else turns up. Rather wait a bit then buy something that you really want.

Have an idea of what you're wanting to build. If you know what you want, then you'll know what to buy.

Shop arround. If you're building up a fiberglass rod, shopping around may save you quite a lot of money to put towards your build which you otherwise would have wasted.

All that glitters is not gold. Don't make this mistake, all too often people find incredible deals and all too often it turns out to be a scam of some sort.

Do your research. Find out if the car has papers and if the seller has any extra paper work relating to the car. Note that with the 'newer' cars you should try to stay away from cars without papers as it's a very difficult and time-consuming process to get papers for the newer vehicles.

When buying your chosen car always make sure you get a written and signed sale agreement. Make sure that you also get a certified copy of the sellers ID, this will help with the registration process when the car is complete and in most cases is often required.

THE CARDINAL RULE.

Never pay a deposit before you've seen the car. Many people have seen a car on the internet, paid a deposit and when they arrive to collect the car it doesn't exist and they've lost their money.
