November 2015 Minutes

Twenty two members attended the MCC meeting at Shoneys in Dandridge on November 3rd..

The minutes from October were read by Secretary Pat Dukes with a motion to accept made by David McGhee and a 2nd from Mike Reading. Accepted by all.

The Treasury report read by Treasurer Bill O'Connell with a first motion to accept made by Don Bentley and a 2nd by Jim Knowlan. Accepted by all.

Before old business even started, Jim Knowlan made a motion to freeze our charities money for the year except for the money already allocated. Bobby Joe Homer made the 2nd. It was passed by majority but not all members.

Old Business: Jim Knowlan stated that a secret ballot needed to be done to select the new officers for 2016 although only one was running for each office. It was Ann Randolph for President 21 votes, Jim Knowlan for Vice President 19 votes, Joan Spoon for Treasurer 21 votes and Pat Dukes to remain Secretary - 21 votes. No write ins were on the ballot.

Jim Knowlan made a motion that everyone attending should let us know in advance so the meat can be ordered. Glenn Allred nominated Jim Knowlan to be over the dinner, ordering the meat and calling members to see if they are attending or not. Glenn thanked Joan Spoon for buying the toys with the monetary donations from the Fill the Truck With Toys cruise in. All of the toys will be donated to Christmas in Jefferson County the week of November 30th.

Scott Noe reported on the Junior Cruzers at the high school. He had a few seniors that graduated last year but more joining this year.

Committee chairs were nominated: Glenn Allred and June Howerton were both nominated for Car Show Coordinator but then Glenn declined after being the main person over the car show events since the club started. Events & Fun Run Coordinator, David McGhee with June Howerton seconding. Charities Coordinator Jeannine Knowlan was nominated with a 2nd from June Howerton. Membership Coordinator nomination was Pat Dukes who has done this for 5 years. David McGhee nominated and Bobby Joe Homer 2nd. David McGhee was nominated for Sergeant of Arms and Joan Spoon was nominated for Chaplain with a 1st from Jeannine Knowlan and a 2nd from Jim Knowlan. These will be finalized in January.

2016 Board of Directors will have to be elected at the January meeting. The By-Laws need lots of revisions done to them.

Glenn gave a very good discussion about when and why the Mossy Creek Cruzers Car Club was started back in 2012. He is one of the founders along with Pat Dukes, Larry Boggess and Jim Burch. He stated how hard it has been to get volunteers to do anything until the time of the car show. Only two or three people carry it until time for the show. He also stated how much the club is changing.
