Users were asked to navigate though that app and see if there are any pain points.

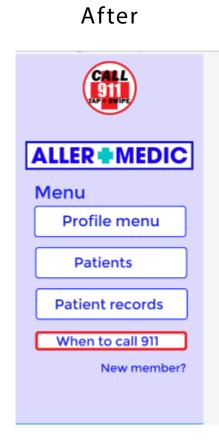

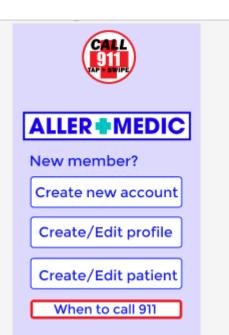
Supporting evidence from the usability study.

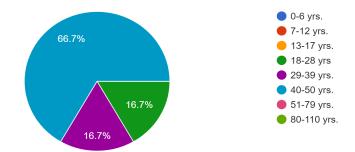

Some form of universal site that doctors, nurses or allergists use to keep up with my results and to detail how critical the allergy is.



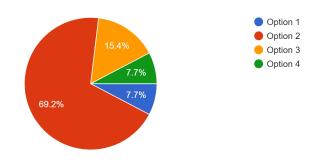

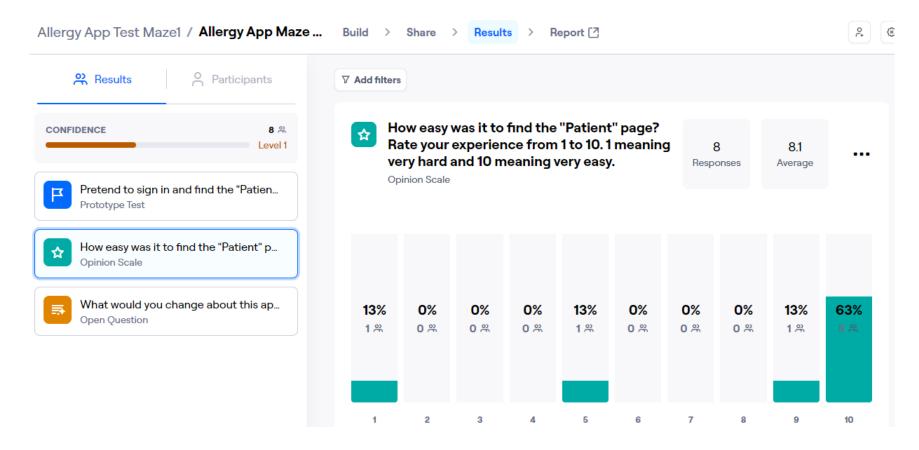


When you think of 911 alert, what symbol signifies a 911 emergency call to you?

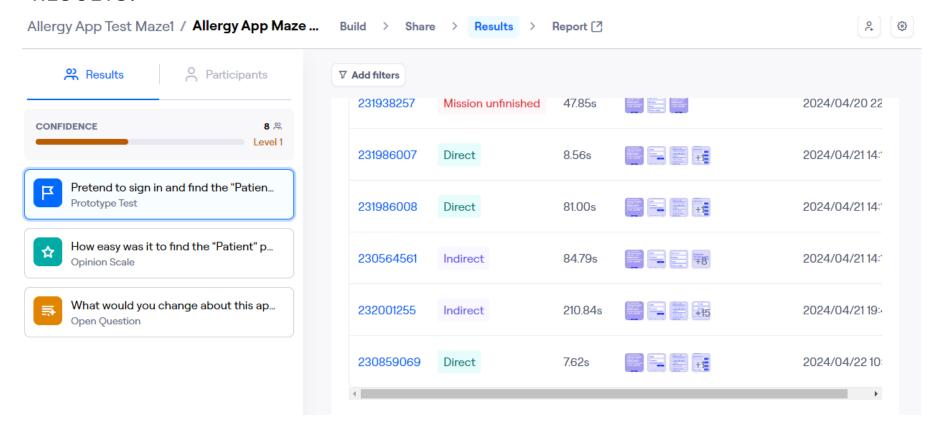

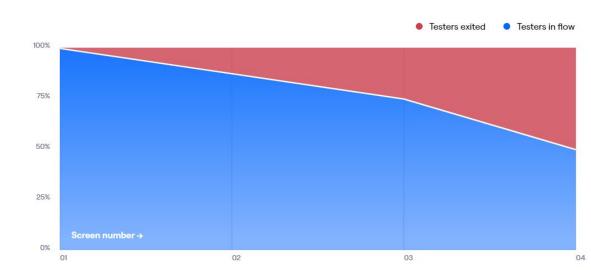
