As a Parent, Spectator or Coach:

- 1. I will enjoy my child's opportunity to experience the benefits of softball.
 - i. I will trust in my child's ability to have fun as well as to perform and achieve excellence on her own.
 - ii. I will help my child to learn the right lessons from winning and losing and from individual accomplishments and mistakes.
 - iii. I will respect my child's teammates and fellow parents as well as the player, parent and coaches of the opposing teams.

- iv. I will give only encouragement and applaud only positive accomplishments whether for my child, her teammates, their opponents or the umpires.
- 2. I will respect my child's coach and support his/her efforts.
 - i. I will not instruct from the sidelines unless asked to by the coach.
 - ii. I will ensure that my child will attend all games and practices and, when not possible, I agree to inform the coach in advance.
 - iii. I will respect all facilities made available so my child can play games and practice softball.
 - iv. I will respect any equipment or uniform that may be loaned to my child so that she can participate.
- 3. I will always respect the umpires and their authority.
- 4. I will never demonstrate threatening or abusive behavior and/or use foul language.
- 5. I will follow all policies/procedures of the City of Beacon Recreation while at the facility.

As a Player:

- 1. I will enjoy the opportunity to experience the benefits of softball.
- 2. I will trust in my ability to have fun as well as to perform and achieve excellence on my own.
- 3. I will help myself to learn the right lessons from winning and losing and from individual accomplishments and mistakes.
- 4. I will respect my parents, teammates, fellow players and coaches of the opposing teams.
- 5. I will give only encouragement and applaud only positive accomplishments whether for teammates, my opponents, the umpires or myself.

- 6. I will respect my coach and support his/her efforts.
- 7. I will do my best to attend all games and practices and, when not possible, I agree to inform the coach in advance.
- 8. I will respect all facilities made available so I can play games and practice softball.
- 9. I will respect any equipment or uniform that may be loaned to me so that I can participate.
- 10. I will always respect the umpires and their authority.
- 11. I will never demonstrate threatening or abusive behavior and/or use foul language.
