Program Guidelines & Priorities:

* Eligible candidates are graduating seniors from Fresno High School with a record of strong academic, athletic and volunteerism in the community, in non-school sponsored activities and participation in extracurricular school activities.

* Applicants must have a GPA of 3.0 and plan to attend a 2- or 4-year college, junior college, or technical school.

* Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the college *in December or January for the second semester of the student's first year*. It will be the student's responsibility to submit the appropriate information necessary at the time of invoice for the second semester tuition and fees, as well as student ID number and college information.

* Applicants must have a letter of recommendation from a FUSD faculty member attesting they are a qualified fit for this scholarship program. This can be a guidance counselor, teacher, administrator or coach.

* Application deadline is June 1 by 5:00 p.m. Pacific Time

* The applications will be reviewed, and the recipient selected by a committee consisting of those who knew Brownie well and know the characteristics of the recipient he would want to see awarded. Applicants are encouraged to visit <u>www.brownievangalder.com</u> for details on his life, passion and legacy.
