Category	Requirements
Individual / Duo / Trio Tumbling	• Routines need to include motions, standing tumble, running tumbling and dance.
Stunt Group	• Routines are restricted to level appropriate building skills. • See level skills breakdown to ensure you register for the correct building level. • Transitions can include tumbling into and out of building skills as long as level appropriate.
