The President's Report June 2024

Thank you all for coming out tonight.

- Welcome back to Saucy's.
- This month we celebrate Father's Day, so Happy Father's Day to all.
- Thank everyone for participating in the Show & Shine. Our servers will be making the pick for the Saucy's Vette of the Month and the winner will receive a Saucy's \$25 gift card a little later tonight.
- This past month had a few events cancelled due to weather and rain, but we have a lot of good stuff coming up. Larry will talk about that a little later.
- I would also like members to submit photos of their cars, as we had a suggestion to create and OCC calendar which I will work on to get printed copies that can be ordered. You can email your pictures directly to me.
- There were inquiries about purchasing Club name tags. The members cost for the magnetic tags will be \$3.00. If you give me the name for the tags, I will order them tomorrow and have by the July meeting. For those not familiar with the name tags see members that have them for example.
- I've also had members ask about club shirts. I have picked some shirts that we will have as Official Club shirts. The cost for the shirts is \$34.00 and includes embroidered OCC Logo. You can order shirts online from Christy and have them shipped directly to you. Eventually, I will have an OCC Store "Everything OCC and Corvettes" setup on the website, Just an easy click to go shopping. I am anticipating a full line of merchandise that can be ordered, Polo's, Tee Shirts, Pullovers, Hoodies, Baseball Caps, Mugs, Tumblers and much more. All of these items can be personalized as you want. I am uploading many different things Corvette related. I'm uploading Generation emblems and Badges and sillouttes for you to choose from and you can upload your favorite picture of your Corvette to have printed on your own personalized it, mug, tumbler, shirt, etc. Unfortunately, this is taking some time, a lot of time to organize. I'm hoping that the Club Shirts will be available by the end of the week to order. WEBSITE: www.shopdsg.us/OCCStore.com
- The next major endeavor is the Groupworks debacle. As most are aware, Groupworks will be going away on June 21st. I want to thank those members that took the time to look around and see what is avaiable. I have made an Executive decision to use a software package called TENDENCI. If you have time, you can look it up on the internet and see the features that the club has access to when I get it all up and running. With this package will be a new website. I am working with a good friend of Sharon's in Kansas City that has been a Computer guy for over 40 years and this is his business and he has many corporate clients across the Country. Him and his wife Christy have been working with me for alost a week now helping me understand as much as my non-geek brain can absorb. The reason I choe this one had a lot to do with the costs of a new app similar to groupworks. As we reviewd many of these, the costs for the Groupworks-like app ranged from \$35 to \$100 per month. That doesn't include the cost of the GoDaddy website of just ubder \$200.00 per year. The cost for the TENDENCI platform has costs as well. Since we own this we need to have a host server. The cost for that is \$25.00/month. (\$300.00 per year). that \$100.00 per year more than GoDaddy, but it gets us a Groupworks-like platform that is more powerful than Groupworks. Oh, I forgot to mention that the cost to OCC for the complete package is FREE for the first year. This included maintenance and instructions by Rick in KC. I have had extensive conversations with Rick Poepping and a little bit of conversation with Dennis and we are hoping that after everything is up and running smoothly, that KC Rick can educate us enough to maintain it ourselves. But, if we need his help, he will be available for a fee. His fee will be determined after a year, and there are other things I am researching to help keep those costs as low as possible.

When all of this is up and running, we will be able to see a calendar of events available to all members. You can click on the date, open the event, RSVP for the event and if it is something that needs registration, a form will be available and registration fees can be paid right from the site. It can track membership and send reminders for dues, and thos too an be paid on the site. It has a section for members to post photos from events as well as a comment section from other members. Another cool feature is that the "OCC Store" is just a click on the site and the website and Facebook will have a link that can automatically update the website with event photos and comments as we choose to allow. These website posts can also be scheduled for specific dates to auto-update so the website look like it's evolving and current. All of this is slightly more than a few button clicks. We can also link the website to facebook, so a click on Facebook will take someone diretly to the website. Keep in mind that everything on the new TENDENCI will be private, controlled by **US** (Administration). The website will be public, same as it is now, but, with the link between features it makes it easy for people that follow OCC on Facebook to have quick access to the website, showing our history, events, etc. I could go on about the features, but I won't at this time. As soon as we believe this is ready to Publish and go Live, you will be invited to join. It will be simple to join (Much easier than Groupworks) because I will have everyone's account set up. All you will need to do is create a personal password. I would encourage you all to simply read through the features on Tendenci.com to see these features.

- We are registered for the July 4th Parade downtown. If you are interested in participating, please let me know. It is currently on Groupworks under "EVENTS" for those interested. We currently have 12 cars signed up and I'm hoping for 20. Once again, I would like to try and get all 8 generations in the parade. Based on other groups of vehicles that participate, I'm not going to limit the number of cars we have. Please select "GOING" on the event. I will keep track and update my list so I can email everyong with any new information
- There is a copy of the current Membership Directory on Groupworks under the "POSTS" tab. I would suggest that everyond download the directory to use until the new site is up and running. It's easy to do and convenient to have on your home computer or phone fro eay viewing
- I would like all members to add my email: ken-mar@sbcglobal.net and my cell number to have quick access to me directly to email or text, in the event you want to plan an event (winery run, day trip, etc.) and I can group email all members for RSVP's to assist in making your event happen. My email and Phone# are in the membership directory.


We are planning to do a run to Meramec Caverns for a day trip for Saturday, July 13, 2024.




