Directions:	<p>Camp will be held at SHADOW RANCH PARK 22633 Vanowen St, West Hills, CA 91307</p> <p>It will be on the Northeast side of Fallbrook and Vanowen. It is on the North side of Vanowen. There is parking on the East side of the park. Close to Sale Avenue. There are multiple parking spaces along the street.</p>
Dates and Hours	<p>2026 SFV Day Camp is June 22-26, 2025. Monday through Friday from 8:30 am to 3:30 pm. Please make sure your scout arrives on time so they can join their den at the start of the day for early morning den activities. We will end the day promptly at 3:30 with a closing flag ceremony. Please be on time to pick up your scout.</p>
Drop-off & Pick-up	<p>Your Scout must be signed in upon arrival and signed out at departure each day of camp.</p>

	<p>For the safety of all participants, each scout can only be picked up by an authorized adult specified on his/her forms.</p> <p>To drop off and pickup - park your car - proceed to the Welcome Table to find the sign in sheets.</p>
Daily Necessities	<p>On the first day of camp we will furnish your scout with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Camp Shirt - scouts should wear this everyday for identification ● Closed-toed shoes are required ● Swimsuits should be worn under clothing on WEDNESDAY & FRIDAY
Camp Essentials	<p>Your scout should bring the following to camp DAILY:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● A backpack/drawstring bag to hold personal items ● Sunscreen and/or Wide Brimmed Hat ● Lunch and snacks in a zip-lock bag: Each den will have a cooler available for lunches and snacks, but since it is not a refrigerator, please avoid packing items that are temperature-sensitive. e.g. mayo, yogurt, creams, ● Reusable water bottle. Water coolers will be available throughout camp to help keep your Scout hydrated, but encouragement from parents to drink plenty of water is always appreciated. <p>REMEMBER: LABEL EVERYTHING</p>
Optional things to bring	<p>If possible, we recommend for your scout to bring:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Change of clothing ● Camping chair ● Camp Table
Buddy System	<p>The Buddy System must always be used at camp!</p> <p>Scouts must stay with a buddy at all times, including when traveling between activities and going to the restroom. Any Scout found without a buddy will be escorted to Headquarters until they can safely rejoin their den.</p>
Archery*	<p>Archery Permission Slip Required: Scouts may not participate until a completed and signed permission slip has been received. This should have been filled out during registration. If you have any questions, please email RADaycamp@gmail.com as soon as possible.</p>
Achievements and Badges	<p>At the end of camp, each Scout will receive a Day Camp Achievement Report listing the requirements completed and achievements earned during the week. Parents are responsible for recording these achievements in Scoutbook+ or their Pack's advancement tracking system.</p>

<p>Medication & Special Needs:</p>	<p>Emergency Medication:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> You must leave medication in its original container with the Health Officer at the First Aid Station <p>For Daily Medication:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> This is NOT the time to take a break from prescribed medication for your children. Kindly make arrangements with the Health Officer as soon as possible if medication is to be taken during the day Include detailed and signed instructions for each medication that the scout needs to take <p>BSA rules do not permit scouts to carry or keep medication, except for rescue inhalers and Epi-Pens.</p> <p>If your scout has special needs, please make sure we know this prior to camp. We have trained volunteers who can assist.</p> <p>You will have a chance to talk to our directors & medical officer at the parents meeting on Wednesday, June 17, 2026 at 6pm.</p> <p>A zoom link will be provided by the Camp Director.</p>
<p>VOLUNTEERS</p> 	<p>RADay Camp is an entirely volunteer run camp - the only payment any of us receive is in the form of the smiles and laughter of your scouts!</p> <p>That being said, we are confident that this summer will be A-MA-ZING! To run a quality program, it takes a village, and we want YOU to join us! Even if you only have a few hours, a day, or better - the whole week - join us!</p> <p>We promise that you will have just as much, if not more fun than your scout! You will not regret it! Some of us have been on this adventure and keep coming back for more!</p>

ADULT VOLUNTEER AGREEMENT

- I agree to the terms of this agreement realizing that this agreement is being used to insure the safety of both the campers and the staff.
- Realizing that I will be leaving the campers for whom I am responsible unattended, I will not leave the Day Camp area anytime campers are present.
- Per Scouting America’s policy of youth protection, I will not at any time allow a situation to develop in which there is a setting involving only one adult/youth staff and one camper/youth staff.
- In order to avoid the possibility of one camper being left unattended, I will maintain and enforce a buddy system at all times. (This includes trips to the bathroom.)
- I will supervise the campers under my charge to the best of my ability and assist the session leaders during all sessions.
- I will be on time according to the arrangement with the Directors concerning my duties.
- I will be constantly alert to any safety hazard that might cause harm to campers or to others.
- I will report any accident, no matter how large or small, that requires First Aid to the Health Officer and Camp Directors.
- If I have any concerns about someone or something at camp, I will communicate my feelings to the Camp Director. I will not provoke or allow confrontations to occur in front of Campers, Youth Staff, or other Adult Staff.
- If I am pleased with someone or something concerning the camp, I will lavish praise upon them, in front of as many Campers, Youth Staff or other Adult Staffers as possible.
- I agree that corporal punishment is not allowed nor is excluding any youth from the group. I agree that if any youth becomes disruptive, bothersome, or disrespectful that I will deliver that youth immediately to the Camp Directors or inform the Directors of the situation.
- I will submit to the Camp Directors on or before the first day of camp, the Annual Health and Medical Record Form, signed and dated for the participant and myself.
- Session Leaders will follow the program set up by the Camp Directors.
- I will wear my camp uniform every day.
- I have read the training materials provided to me by the Camp Directors and understand my duties as listed.
- I will be responsible for all camp materials.
- I have completed Safeguarding Youth Training and will furnish a copy of the certificate to the Camp directors on/or before the start of camp.

As compensation for performing these services, I am entitled to as much personal satisfaction of a job well done as I can muster, I can pick up as much fun as I can handle, I can have all the dirty faced smiles that my eyes can absorb, and I can sleep well at night knowing that I may have positively influenced the future.

10. I promise to take part in each activity and to help each and every camper. I promise to lead by example as each camper looks up to me.
