Lapidary Fundamentals: Gemstone Faceting By: Frank Brower Gemstone faceting is a marvelous mixture of engineering and art. Through a mechanical process of cutting, grinding and polishing surfaces on a piece of crystal, beautiful gems are created!

Faceting continued....

Frank Brower presented a fascinating program on faceting. It is the process of grinding & polishing that creates a beautiful finished stone that is suitable for jewelry. This process is performed on a faceting machine. Frank also uses a binocular magnifier so he can better see the cuts on the stone as he is making them. Each member was given a copy of a Chrysanthemum Cut. This is the cut he uses when faceting marbles. Frank can facet a marble in 2 hours. When faceting a stone, one must follow the indexes as listed in the instructions exactly for a cut. This process is very tedious & requires much patience. Your faceting machine must also be set up accurately to achieve the cut you desire. Once the bottom of the stone is cut, it is moved to a transfer block in order to facet the top part of the stone. Other important materials used to secure the stone during the faceting process include: Super Glue, epoxy, or dop wax and a dop stick. Frank also showed examples of various materials such as rough stone, glass, & marbles that can be used during the faceting process.
