

FIRST 48 HOURS AFTER RELEASE

for Folks moving to Jacksonville after prison

Don't panic.

You do not need to accomplish everything on this list on the first day. Focus on the items marked "Urgent" first. Once those are completed, work through the remaining items one step at a time.

URGENT TASKS

These are rated as urgent because failure to accomplish them can be a violation of your probation.

1. Probation Check-in (Florida Department of Corrections Probation)
 - a. -  908 N Jefferson St, Building F, Jacksonville FL 32209
 - b.  904-696-5970
 - c. Must Register the day you arrive in Jacksonville
 - d. They close at 5pm
 - e. Average time 2-4 hours
 - f. Costs- None
2. Sign Lease and Secure a legal address with Mulligan House
 - a. -  5467 W. Beaver Street, Jacksonville FL 32254
 - b.  904-834-8411
 - c. Must have this secured on the first day.
 - d. Be sure to call and text to keep us informed when you plan to arrive so we can meet you and help you get checked in. We are typically open between 9am and 5pm.
 - e. Average time 1 hour
 - f. Costs- You should have already paid \$650.00 for your security deposit. Your first month's rent will be due **before** you move in.
3. Felony Registration- JREC Jacksonville Re-entry Center (Sheriff's Office)
 - a. -  1024 Superior Street, Jacksonville FL 32254
 - b.  904-630-8600
 - c. Must register with-in 48 hours after being released or moving
 - d. Average time 1 hour
 - e. Cost- None
4. Get a Drivers License or State ID (Duval Tax Collectors Office)
 - a. -  231 E Forsyth St, Jacksonville, FL 32202
 - b.  904-255-5700
 - c. Must have with-in 48 hours after moving
 - d. There are other addresses that you could find on-line. You can go to any office
 - e. Average time 2 -4 hours
 - f. Costs- Driver's License \$48.00 State ID \$25.00
