

Testimonial

A Program Manager from the Pottstown Recovery Learning Center (PRLC) contacted Rahab's Hope on behalf of her client Albert. She shared that she was working with a gentleman who had been homeless for 2.5 years until she was able to find an apartment for him within his budget. The landlord allowed Albert to move into the unit prior to paying the security deposit, first and last month's rent totaling \$1,800 with the understanding that the balance would be paid by a local agency that Albert was actively working with at the time. Due to health challenges, he was unable to complete the agency's application process before their funding was exhausted. No longer having the support needed, and unable to cover the full balance himself, Albert was at risk of becoming homeless again. Rahab's Hope collaborated with Albert and the Program Manager to finalize a rental assistance application, securing \$1,000 in support for him, while he covered the remaining \$800 directly with the landlord. Albert is now securely in his home without the physiological distress caused by unstable housing. After being approved for assistance, he shared, ""I am very blessed to have had patient people and giving people help me with my needs. The Recovery Learning Center and Rahab's Hope worked together to help me. This opportunity helped me get a place when I needed it most. I am no longer homeless because of the funding from Rahab's Hope. I am blessed to have had such a great experience with your agency and I am truly arateful."


