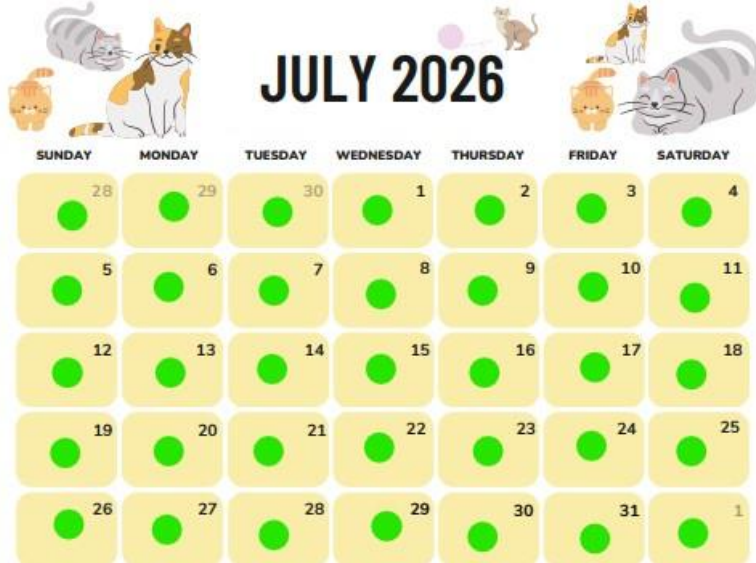
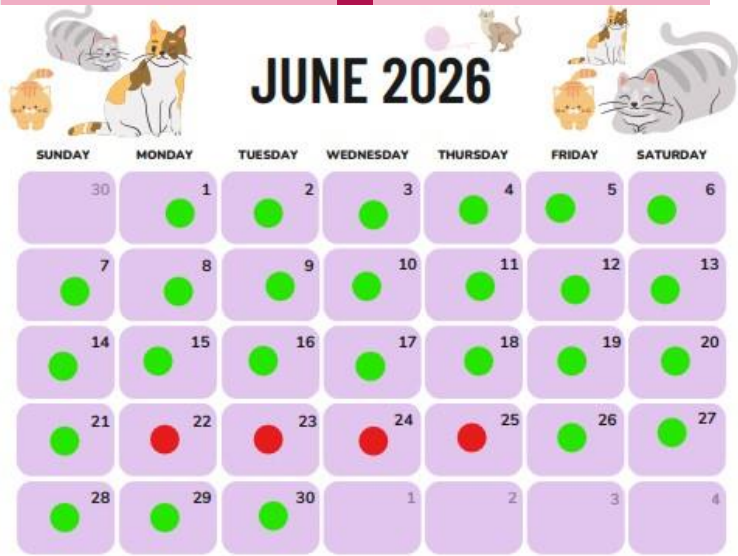

CAT TRIVIA

Only one in 3000 torties is male. The orange colour in the coats is passed through the female X chromosome, but the XX chromosome results in ginger and another colour being mixed in the coat.

In XY chromosomes the fur is either entirely ginger or has no ginger pigment, so a male tortie needs to have a rare genetic mutation producing an extra X chromosome.

SUMMER CAT CARE TIPS

- On hot days, the RSPCA recommends putting ice cubes in your cat's water bowl to help keep them cool and hydrated.
- Running water is also helpful, so a water fountain can encourage cats to drink. Metal or ceramic fountains are better in warm weather, as they are less likely to develop algae.
- Frozen treats can be very popular – a Lik-e-lix from the freezer can provide a delicious cool snack. Ice lollies for your cat!
- If your cat goes outside or spends a long time basking in the sun, you can consider pet-safe suncream for their ears and nose, especially if they have pale fur – cats can suffer from sunburn!
- Make sure they have a shady spot to retreat to when the Scottish sun is just too strong...
