

ARP ESSER III PLAN- Lone Star School \$ 1,111,896.10

After meeting with stakeholders, Lone Star School is submitting the following plan on how ARP/ESSER III funds will be used to implement curriculum, make up for learning loss, and reopen our school safely.

20% OF THE ARP relief dollars will address student learning loss due to lost instructional time through evidence-based interventions. Lone Star School plans on using the money for an extended school year. We determined that an extra fifteen minutes per day equates to six extra days of teaching all students and underrepresented student subgroups, meeting their academic, social, and emotional needs as well. All teachers, administrators, and support personnel would need to be compensated for the extra days of work. This would be done with a one-time stipend of \$2,500 for support (20) and \$3,000 (62) for certified for a total of **\$ 236,000 + benefits.** That is just over 26% of total funds. We would not have time to change the calendar or give our stakeholders adequate time for quality input before the fall of 2021 due to the summer deadline for this plan. However, we will implement this change in the calendar in the 2022-2023 school year. This will give us sufficient time to poll more of our parents, teachers, students, teacher union, and community to decide on the best use of those extra teaching days/time used to make up for learning loss. It would also give our patrons sufficient notification that we will be in the classroom extra days, as many had already planned vacations during the publicized 2021-2022 calendar. Taking this extra time to plan this change would also allow us to possibly add these days to the beginning of the academic year where we feel the most quality learning occurs.

(K)The next money will be used for purchasing education technology (including hardware, software, and connectivity for students who are served by the local educational agency that aids in regular and substantive educational interaction between students in their classroom instructors including low-income students and children with disabilities, which may include assistive technology or adaptive equipment.
