2 bedroom HC Rate: **\$932.00** 3 bedroom HC Rate: **\$1028** 4 bedroom HC Rate: **\$1105**

Making Housing Charge Payments

There are several ways that you can pay for your housing charges:

- 1. You can write a cheque for each month on file at the office
- 2. Money order
- 3. Write a cheque each month
- 4. Email money through E-transfer to office@kawarthavillagecoop.ca
- 5. Request a document from the office that will give permission for Alterna (Coop's bank) to automatically withdraw the funds from your account

The office will not accept any cash under any circumstances.

March 1 Housing Charge "Top Up Amount"

On March 1 you will have an additional one time payment to cover the increase in your Last Months Housing Charge and Maintenance Deposit.

March 1st Housing Charge Top Up amount

2 bedroom = \$38 3 bedroom = \$42 4 Bedroom = \$45

This is payable by etransfer or cheque. Cash will not be accepted.

For those who have paid by direct deposit your Maintenance deposit increase will be minus \$20

| Children under the age of 18 | Now (started June 27, 2024) |
| All remaining eligible Canadian residents | In 2025 |
