

The Board of Directors would like to express their sincere gratitude to all those members for completing the maintenance self-assessment and risk management forms. Your cooperation helps ensure that our homes and community remain safe and well-maintained for everyone.

We are now moving forward with Phase Two of the Maintenance Review, which is a mandatory process and part of the co-op's mandate to maintain the property in good condition and meet legal and safety obligations.

In the latter part of July and throughout August, a Senior Engineer with over 30 years of experience will be inspecting each unit in the community.

Keep an eye out for your notification letter, which will include the specific date and time window for your unit's inspection.

To help the process run smoothly:

- ✓ If you will not be home during your scheduled time, please ensure the office has a copy of your key.
- ✓ Place any pets in a safe and secure location during the inspection.
- ✓ Plan for the inspection to take approximately 30 to 60 minutes.
- ✓ Photographs of the issues maybe taken to assist in hiring and/or informing contractors of the specific issue.

We appreciate your cooperation in this important and required process, which helps keep our homes safe, functional, and welcoming for everyone.
