

KVC Playground Rules and Expectations

Summer Holidays are upon us and so we are asking our community parents to be mindful of the playground expectations. To keep our playground a safe and welcoming space for all children and families, please follow these community rules:

1. Be Kind and Respectful

- Treat everyone with kindness and fairness.
- Bullying, teasing, name-calling, or exclusion will not be tolerated.
- Be inclusive—invite others to play and take turns with equipment.

2. Use Respectful Language

- Profanity, swearing, or inappropriate language is strictly prohibited.
- Speak to others the way you would like to be spoken to.

3. Keep Our Playground Clean and Safe

- Tagging, graffiti, or writing on any surfaces (fences, slides, benches, etc.) is not allowed.
- Respect the property—do not damage or deface playground equipment.
- Take your garbage with you or use designated bins.

4. Play Safely

- Use the equipment as intended.
- No roughhousing, pushing, or climbing on areas not meant for play.
- Be mindful of younger children and help keep the space safe for all ages.

5. Adult Supervision and Responsibility

- Children under 12 should be supervised by a responsible adult or older sibling.
- Parents and guardians are responsible for their children's behaviour.
- If problematic behaviours (e.g., bullying, profanity, or vandalism) persist, families may be contacted and asked to meet with the Board of Directors to discuss next steps.

6. Respect Quiet Hours

- Playground use is permitted between 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m.
- Please keep noise levels reasonable, especially in the evening.

7. Be Proud of Our Space

- This is your community—let's work together to keep it clean, friendly, and safe.
- If you see something concerning, let a parent, guardian, or the KVC office know.
