
Personal Information Protection Policy

Personal Information Protection Policy

The Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act (PIPEDA) is a federal law that came into effect on January 1, 2004. Kawartha Village Co-op has developed this policy, which is compliant with the Act, and will ensure that the privacy of members is respected.

- 1. The co-op will ensure that it follows PIPEDA rules and it's principles. The Board of Directors will act as the co-op's "Privacy Officer".
- The co-op shall only collect personal information that it requires to ensure sound management of the co-op to fulfil its obligations to its members and the government.
- The co-op shall use and share personal information only with the agreement of the individuals concerned.
- The co-op will store personal information securely to prevent unauthorized use.
 The co-op will destroy personal information when the co-op no longer needs it.
- 5. Individuals will, on request, have access to personal information about themselves that the co-op has. The co-op will correct any errors in personal information that the individual brings to its attention.
