25 Things to Pray About

6. Pray for the members of your church, including your pastor and her/his family.
7. Ask God to use you to be a light to those who you come across, and a testament of the goodness of God to those who are in need.
8. Pray that God would use you as an encouragement to those who are discouraged, downtrodden, and weary.
9. Ask God to give you a heart that is responsive to His word and is sensitive to the leading of the Holy Spirit.
