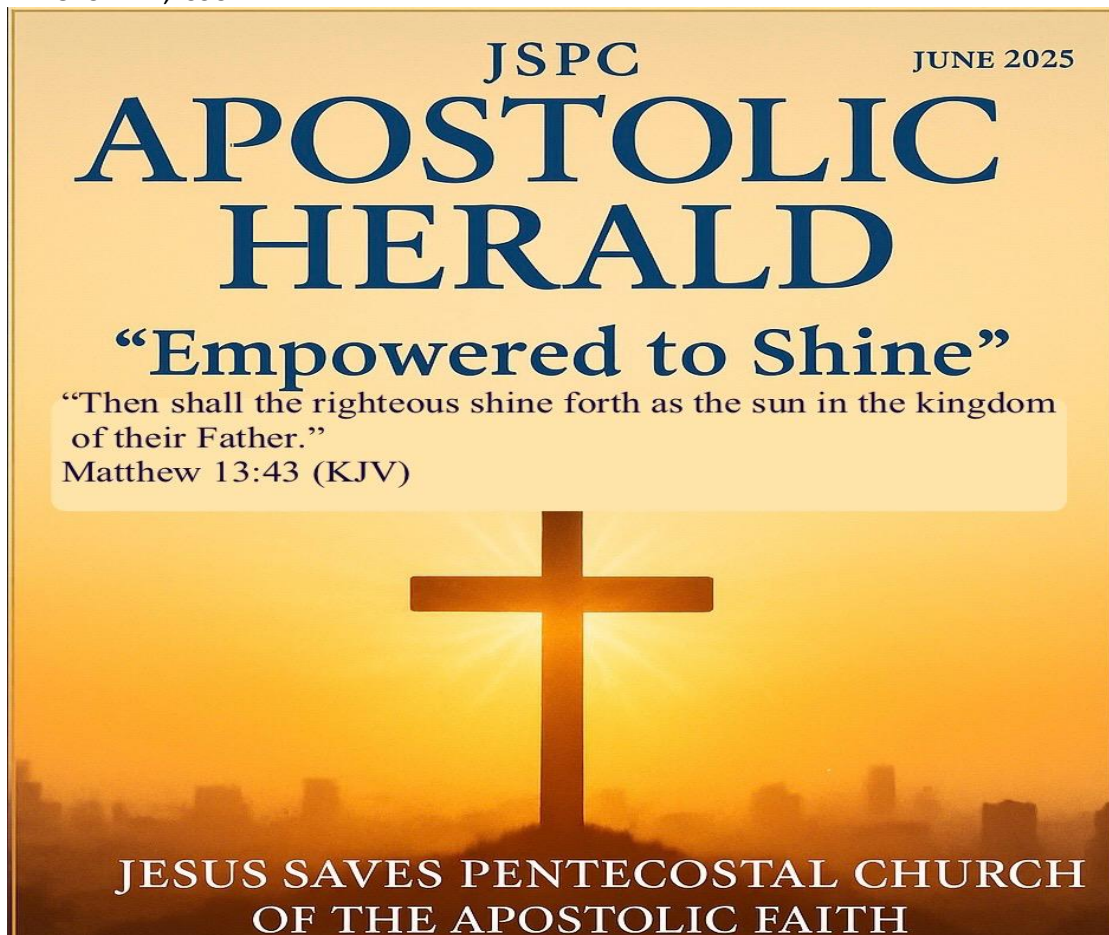

Confession of Faith

I Believe:

In One True God: That there is only one living and true God, revealed to us as Father in creation, Son in redemption, and Holy Ghost in regeneration (Deuteronomy 6:4; Isaiah 9:6; 1 Timothy 3:16).

In Jesus Christ: That Jesus Christ is God manifested in the flesh, fully God and fully man, born of a virgin, crucified, buried, and resurrected. He is the only Savior of the world (John 1:1, 14; Colossians 2:9; Acts 4:12).

In the Plan of Salvation: That salvation comes by grace through faith, and according to Acts 2:38, we must repent, be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and receive the gift of the Holy Ghost, evidenced by speaking in other tongues (Ephesians 2:8; Acts 2:38; Acts 10:44–48).

In the Power of the Holy Ghost: That the Holy Ghost is essential for victorious living and empowers believers with spiritual gifts and fruit for Christian service (Acts 1:8; Galatians 5:22–23; 1 Corinthians 12).

In the Holy Scriptures: That the Bible is the inspired, infallible Word of God and our ultimate authority for faith and life (2 Timothy 3:16–17; Psalm 119:105).

In Living a Holy Life: That we are called to live a life separated from sin, devoted to God, and committed to righteousness inwardly and outwardly (Romans 12:1–2; 1 Peter 1:15–16; Hebrews 12:14).

In the Second Coming of Jesus Christ: That Jesus will return for His church. The dead in Christ will rise first, and those who are alive will be caught up to meet Him in the air (1 Thessalonians 4:16–17; Titus 2:13).

Personal Confession:

I confess with my mouth and believe in my heart that Jesus Christ is Lord.

I turn from my sins and submit my life to Him.

I believe in the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus.

I have been baptized in His name, filled with His Spirit, and I choose to follow Him all the days of my life.

Ways to Serve

I. Ways to Serve in the Church

- Prayer Team – Intercede for members, services, and the community.
- Altar Ministry – Assist during altar calls and minister to those in need.
- Usher/Greeter – Welcome people with love and help them feel at home.
- Children's Ministry – Teach or assist with young children or youth.
- Music Ministry – Sing, play instruments, or help with sound/media.
- Teaching or Small Groups – Lead Bible studies or discipleship groups.
- Hospitality Ministry – Prepare meals, set up events, or host fellowships.
- Cleaning and Maintenance – Keep the house of God in order.
- Transportation Team – Drive others to church services or events.
- Outreach & Evangelism – Go into the community to share the gospel.

II. Ways to Serve in the Community

- Feed the Hungry – Volunteer at shelters or prepare care packages.
- Visit the Sick or Elderly – Bring encouragement and prayer to shut-ins or nursing homes.
- Mentorship – Guide teens or young adults in faith and life decisions.
- Random Acts of Kindness – Pay for someone's meal, groceries, or write encouraging notes.
- Support Local Schools – Offer tutoring, school supplies, or sponsor a child.
- Support Single Mothers or Widows – Babysit, do yard work, or help with errands.
- Help the Homeless – Distribute hygiene kits, socks, or warm meals.
- Crisis Support – Be a calm presence for those grieving or in distress.

III. Ways to Serve Daily

- Listen Intentionally – Be present and truly hear someone's heart.
- Speak Life – Encourage, bless, and uplift others with your words.
- Offer Your Skills – Use your talents (writing, design, mechanics, etc.) to help someone.
- Forgive Quickly – Serve by showing grace and promoting reconciliation.
- Be Generous – Give not just money, but time, attention, and love.
- Live as a Light – Simply walking in joy, peace, and integrity ministers to others.
