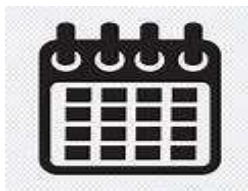

Daily Confessions Based on God's Word

The part of the Word we acknowledge is the part of the Word we partake of.”

In other words, whatever truth you speak, believe, and agree with, becomes the truth you experience.

Each confession below is written so you can take hold of a specific truth from Scripture and partake of it in your life.

1. Confession of Identity

“I acknowledge that I am who God says I am. I am a new creation, forgiven, loved, and chosen. I partake of my identity in Christ today.”

2. Confession of Peace

“I acknowledge that Jesus is my peace. I receive His peace in my mind, emotions, and decisions. Today I partake of supernatural calm and stability.”

3. Confession of Strength

“I acknowledge that the joy of the Lord is my strength. I receive strength for every assignment, every challenge, and every responsibility.”

4. Confession of Provision

“I acknowledge that God is my provider. I partake of His supply today—spiritually, emotionally, and financially. I lack nothing in Christ.”

5. Confession of Healing

“I acknowledge that by His stripes I am healed. I partake of health, wholeness, and restoration in my body and mind.”

6. Confession of Wisdom

7. Confession of Guidance

8. Confession of Protection

9. Confession of Victory

10. Confession of Purpose
