However, in this edition we would like to tell you a bit about ourselves.

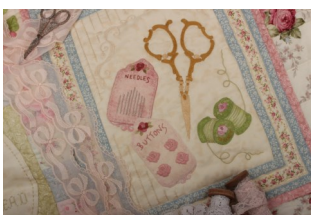

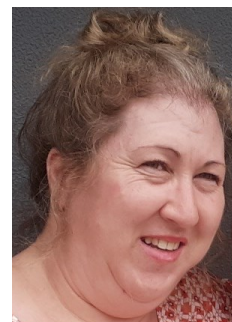
