Frequently Asked Questions: What is needed to prepare a quilt for quilting?

It's important to have both your backing and wadding 6" larger than the quilt top, around **all four sides**, **therefore purchase your backing 12" larger than your quilt.** You do not need to trim off the excess in the opposite direction as it works best if we have the straight edges of the selvedge to align your quilt. Checking for any open seams on the edges as they come apart during quilting, particularly quilts that have been done using the strip piecing method. A basting stitch ½: around the edges of your quilt will prevent distortions.
