Short-Term (STR) & Rentals

STR/Rentals require an application to receive a License/Permit. Visit our website for information regarding the STR/Rental Ordinance.

Rental properties require inspections from the Health Dept. and Fire Department.

A few reminders:

- Changes on property will require an approved permit. Contact Zoning Administrator to issue permits.
- Most signs and outdoor storage containers require a permit.
- Point of sale inspections: It protects our main asset, the river and lake. An approved inspection of your well and septic is required for the sale of any property or change of ownership. The inspection, once approved is good for 5 years.

Please be aware of the change of the Fireworks Ordinance. Dates and times of usage can be found on the website. There will be a fine of \$1,000.00 for each violation.

Garbage Collection

Normal garbage collection is on Mondays from 6am to 8pm. Exceptions are holidays and weather conditions.

Call ahead for large item trash pickup. Be sure to state you are in Secord Twp and give your full address.

Recycling will be picked up on **every other** Thursday for the entire Township. Yard Waste pick-up is Tuesday between 6am and 8pm from April through November. Yard waste should be in biodegradable paper bags or open containers specifically marked as YARD Waste. Yard waste is defined as leaves, grass clippings, twigs (branches less than 1 inch) and dried lake debris.

It is illegal to blow debris into the water!!! We advise you NOT to burn leaves in the ditches due to the eventual run-off that will find its way to the river and promote weed growth. We also now have natural gas in many areas and the lines run through the ditches. Burning over a gas line is very dangerous.

Property Taxes

Property taxes are billed twice each year 2024 Summer Taxes, July – Sept. 16, 2024, Winter Taxes Dec – Feb. 14, 2025 payable at the Township.

Late payments paid after Feb 14 2025 <u>must</u> be paid directly to the Gladwin County Treasures office [late fee will apply].

Payment by mail is preferred

The office will be open all day 9-5 on December 27, 2024 & February 13, 2025. Other walk-in's call for appointment 810-730-6872.

Cash payments MUST be EXCACT.

Post marks not accepted. Receipts mailed only with self-addressed stamped envelope.

To pay online: secorddtwp.com, vender charges a 3% (minimum \$1.50) fee. If using e-checks make sure your property ID is noted on the check. Credit cards are accepted only on line. This is though our web site; www.secordtwp.com

We also have a Drop box next to door at 1507 Secord Dam Rd. to receive your payment.

Please note that your address on your bill is correct, sending changes back with your payment if necessary.

Apply Brine to all remaining dirt roads within the township (4.31 Miles)

Crack Seal Sector 2 (8.4 miles)

Chip and Seal Lakeshore Drive one mile south of Secord Dam Road

Pave Secord Dam Road (1.4 miles) between Lakeshore Drive and Three Rivers Road Pave Lakeshore Dr. from Wirtz Rd. North to the Township Border (1.5 miles)

Pave Whitetail Trail from where it starts on M30 to Fawn Lane, Fawn Lane to M30, and Deer Run Rail to Fawn Lane (basically the entire loop M30 to M30 plus Deer Run Trail

Mow ditches within the township to provide more visibility of the wildlife in the ditch areas.

Dead fall cleanup is the responsibility of the property owner
