

Guide to Coaching Travel Soccer—Design Document

Subject	Topics to Include
<i>Business Purpose</i>	<p>Over the past decade, Portland Soccer Club coaches that have transitioned from the recreational soccer program to the travel program have not been trained on requirements and expectations. This has led to confusion, conflicts, and last-minute rushes to get required tasks completed.</p> <p>This course will provide training and a resource, so all coaches are clear on their expected responsibilities and prepare them to lead a team through a soccer season. They will know how to schedule games of different types and what their responsibilities are on game day as well as how to plan a practice</p>
<i>Target Audience</i>	All Travel Soccer Coaches in Portland Soccer Club
<i>Training Time</i>	<p>20 minutes</p> <p><i>This does not include the time required to do additional trainings that are linked</i></p>
<i>Training Recommendation</i>	<p>One eLearning course created in Articulate Rise. This is the best format because it allows learners to identify the expectations of a travel coach in the Portland Soccer Club.
