Over the past couple of weeks the leadership team of the Pocatello Pioneers have participated in statewide meetings with *IICL officials and team directors and have met as the Pocatello Pioneers board to discuss options and plans for the 2020 **NICA ICCL Mountain Bike Season. Please beware of the following details and adjustments for this season.

Details about races in the fall are still pending. The IICL officials are exploring many options to provide race opportunities but we don't know what this fall will bring. Please be aware that it is possible this season that there will not be any league wide races this year. They have given us the date of 1 Aug 2020 to make final decisions about a race season. Registration is now open for student athletes to join the Pocatello Pioneers Mountain Bike Team at <u>www.pocatellopioneers.com</u>. Both IICL and Pocatello Pioneers Team Fees and registration are required to participate in any activity with the team. Fees are non-refundable. League registration fees have been reduced from \$175 per student athlete to \$135. No race purchases are available at this time as the details of races are still in question. Pocatello Pioneers fee remains at \$55. (one of the lowest team fees in the state)

We will not be holding a parent meeting this year. Student athletes will not be able to participate in any rides without the submission of this completed form.

We have a resigned team jersey from Hyperthreads and it is sweet! (Thank you Toni Folks for the great design) Student athletes who are new to the team will receive a jersey as part of your registration fee. We have made the purchase of the new jersey optional this year since there is uncertainty regarding the racing part of the season. For 2021, all riders will need to have the new jersey.
