

Belmont High School ALL NIGHT PARTY
Parent/Student Contract 2026

This contract states the rules that must be followed at the 2025 Senior All Night Graduation Party (ANP). By signing your name to the contract you acknowledge the following rules and will abide by them, and understand that if you violate the rules, you will be subject to the consequences as listed below. Both students and parent/guardian must sign this contract in order to buy a ticket and attend the ANP.

Rules and Consequences

1. Students must arrive between 9:00 pm and 10:00 pm on June 6,2026. No one will be admitted after 10pm.
CONSEQUENCE: Student will be denied admission

2. **No bags are allowed.** Any pocketbook/belongings will be searched and labeled and will be made available to be picked up at the end of the party. Do not bring any valuable items, as the ANP is not responsible for lost or stolen items. **Medications** can be checked in with the health/safety staff on duty. **No beverages or containers** may be brought into the ANP.
CONSEQUENCE: School rules will apply

3. Students must remain within the physical boundaries of the ANP area, which is limited to the cafeteria, the field house, the upper gym, the black box theater and the connecting corridor. A student may not leave the ANP before 5:00 AM on June 7TH unless approval is obtained from authorized ANP chaperone after contacting the student's parent or a parent of the student has notified the ANP organizers in advance of the party.
CONSEQUENCE: If a student is found beyond the specified areas, a parent will be called and a student will be sent home.

4. Inappropriate gestures, language, or behaviors will not be accepted.
CONSEQUENCE: A parent will be called and the student will be sent home

5. THE ANP is smoke, vape, alcohol and substance free. This includes all areas of the ANP.
CONSEQUENCE: School rules will apply

Students will attend the ANP alcohol and drug free. An ANP representative, health/safety staff member or law enforcement official will evaluate students as deemed warranted. The school and ANP staff reserve the right to utilize any appropriate methodology to determine if a student is alcohol or drug impaired. It shall be a violation of the alcohol and drug impaired for any student to display evidence of:

1. Using or having used alcohol and/or drugs.
2. Possessing alcohol and/or drugs.
3. Being knowingly in the presence of alcohol and/or drugs.
4. Transferring or transporting alcohol and/or drugs.
5. Knowingly or willfully assisting another person in using alcohol and/or drugs.

CONSEQUENCE: Parents will be notified immediately and students will be sent home. If a parent is not available, the student will be placed in the custody of the local police department.
