

## Purpose

The Boilermakers Local 154 Memorial Scholarship Fund was established in 2004 to provide an annual \$5,000 scholarship to a members' dependent child in the name and memory of deceased members of Local 154.

Originally, the program was established in the name of Tim Adamson, a Local 154 Apprentice who died on June 14, 2004, while working at the Scrubgrass Power Plant Project.

On August 30, 2017, Local 154 suffered the loss of two Journeyman Boilermakers, Kevin Bachner and John Gorchock while they were working at the Bruce Mansfield Power Plant.

Following this tragic accident, the Scholarship committee made the decision to change the name to the Boilermakers Local 154 Memorial Scholarship Fund to encompass the memory of *all* deceased members of Local 154.

- The successful applicant will be notified no later than July 1, 2026.

- Any change in the educational status of the Scholarship Recipient must be reported to the Scholarship Committee.
- The selection of the winner by the Scholarship Committee is final and binding.
