

Purpose

The Boilermakers Local 154 Memorial Scholarship Fund was established in 2004 to provide an annual \$5,000 scholarship to a members' dependent child in the name and memory of deceased members of Local 154.

Originally, the program was established in the name of Tim Adamson, a Local 154 Apprentice who died on June 14, 2004 while working at the Scrubgrass Power Plant Project.

On August 30, 2017, Local 154 suffered the loss of two Journeyman Boilermakers, Kevin Bachner and John Gorchock while they were working at the Bruce Mansfield Power Plant.

Following this tragic accident, the Scholarship committee made the decision to change the name to the Boilermakers Local 154 Memorial Scholarship Fund to encompass the memory of *all* deceased members of Local 154.

- The essay date will be determined and sent to you along with 3 prospective essay questions upon receipt of your application.
- There will be a three (3) hour time limit to complete the essay.
- The winner will be selected by the Scholarship Committee and will be based on the evaluation of a 300-500-word essay. The possible essay topics will be provided upon receipt of application.

- The successful applicant will be notified no later than June 21, 2021 and will be awarded at the Local 154 Kennywood Picnic
- The Scholarship Award will be made payable to the college, vocational school or university of their choice after acceptance or admission and mailed there directly.
- Any change in the educational status of the Scholarship Recipient must be reported to the Scholarship Committee.
- The selection of the winner by the Scholarship Committee is final and binding.

- Applicants must be High School seniors enrolled in public or private schools, with a high school GPA of a C (2.0) or its equivalent.
- Must be a son, daughter, legally adopted child or dependent of any member in good standing or retired member of Boilermakers Local Lodge 154.
- Applicants must submit an application within the specified time limits along with additional information specified.
- Applications must be typed or legibly handwritten, mailed and postmarked by May 14, 2021.
