Youth Leaders 9 Pin No Tap Tournament Format and Rules

2025-2026 Season

This tournament is set up and based on many different playing factors; we will list these in the rules for explanation. This is a youth tournament for scholarship monies to be determined after the end of all stops, with disbursements to SMART

This tournament is usually held in the 5 centers of the Upstate Association, but we have decided to expand and reach out to other centers in the area, outside of the association for competition.

2025-2026 Season Rules/Regulations

* Open to ALL Youth Bowlers

making that division contain bowlers with averages <=120

- * Payout Ratio is 1:6 Scholarships earned at each stop and paid at the end of the season
- * Cost per Event \$25.00

 - This tournament is set up in 4 divisions. Division I will bowl scratch with no handicap. Division II, Division III, and
 - Division IV will be handicap divisions with handicap based on 90% of 220. Division IV will only be ran at events with at least 5 participants in that division. Should Division IV have less than 5 participants it will combine with Division III
 - Divisions Average Handicap Division I >=171 Scratch 90% of 220 Division II 121-170 Division III 101-120 90% of 220 Division IV <=100 90% of 220
 - Entering average will be the higher of Previous Year Book Average or current league average with a minimum of 21 games. Divisions will be based on your Entering Average. Please make sure you BRING A CURRENT LEAGUE STANDING SHEET. Should a bowler not have a current standing sheet available at the event for average verification they will bowl in Division I. We will allow 24 hours

to provide a current league sheet, for average verification and division placement. After 24 hours,

- scores are final. Once you have been placed in a division you may move up a division based on average, but you will not be allowed to bowl down a division. You must bowl at the higher division for the remainder of the season.
- This is an accumulative scoring tournament. Overall Champion as well as Division Champions will be determined based on the folowing point isystem. Should points result in a tie it will defalt to total pins with the scratch division bowlers receiving their handicap pins at the same 90% of 220 that the other divisions recieve.
- How Point System Works
 - * Must Bowl 5 out of 8 Stops

 - * Bowler Recieves point value of the place the finish in for their division
 - * EX: 1st Place recieves 1 point; 2nd Place recieves 2 points; etc.
 - Once a bowler competes in 5 events the total points are divided by the total number
 - * of stops bowled to create the bowlers point value for the season
- * The maximum score with handicap will be capped at 300. * No Smoking/Vaping
- * No Hitting or Kicking of Ball returns allowed
- * No showing of disrespect to any bowler or tournament official allowed
- * The use of profanity is strictly forbidden

- * Tournament Directors have the final say in all matters not covered above
