

## 2025 Arizona Tax Credits

There are five (5) Arizona Tax Credits that can be claimed simultaneously for the 2025 tax year for individuals.

These credits can be claimed as an itemized deduction on your Federal tax return and a dollar-for-dollar credit on your Arizona tax return. They are NOT refundable, meaning if you have less tax than credits, you do not get a refund back of the excess credit. But you can CARRYFORWARD the excess credits and claim them on your 2026 tax return.

You have until April 15, 2026 to make the tax credit donation. If you want to claim the credit on your 2025 tax return, please make sure you designate that the donation is for the 2025 tax year.

The maximum amounts that can be donated are based on your 2025 filing status. Married Filing Jointly (MFJ), Single/Head of Household/Married Filing Separately are listed as "Others" and have the lower limit.

1. AZ Military Family Relief Fund (\$400 for MFJ, \$200 Others)

2. Qualified Foster Care Organization (\$1,234 MFJ, \$618 Others). I recommend Voices for CASA Children:

3. Private Schools (\$3,062 MFJ, \$1,535 Others) these credits CANNOT be given for your child's tuition but can be given for a friend's.
4. Public Schools (\$400 MFJ, \$200 Others) these credits CAN be given for your own child's activities.
5. Qualified Charitable Organizations (\$987 MFJ, \$495 Others) such as food banks, homeless shelters and abused women and children's shelters. Two that I always recommend are:
