UNFINISHED BUSINESS: Approval of transferring cash bank accounts to higher interest bearing accounts has been tabled until further notice.

NEW BUSINESS: This meeting is being held by via Zoom (a computer app) to comply with state social distancing regulations and in an effort to stop the spread of COVID-19. A meeting was deemed necessary because of the need for a budget and other business considerations for the summer.

<u>Paving bids</u> have been requested from 7 Peaks Paving, Tri-State Paving and Vic Russell. 1.1 miles of road are scheduled to be paved this year. These roads include Killdeer, Grebe, Auklet, Gull, Curlew, and Egret. A round-robin discussion was held for the paving estimates.

- <u>-Snow removal</u> needs to be better dispersed throughout OWW next winter since Marsh Hawk road was missed or done late. Homeowners are encouraged to reach out to MHCM in the future when the problem arises.
- <u>-Marina security</u>: this issue has been tabled review of the Marina Committee's report. Signage is a consideration rather than a gate. This will be but on the next BOD's agenda for discussion.
