Democrat Brittany McKinley, attorney and President of the Human Relations Commission of the City of Los Angeles, lives in the center of the 24th State Senate District—the district she is now running to represent.





EDUCATION & FAMILY HISTORY



Born in the district and a graduate of Loyola Marymount University, Brittany McKinley credits much of her family's early success to the stability provided by local union work. Her grandfather, along with his brother, were both transit workers for L.A. RTD (now called MTA) and members of the Amalgamated Transit Union. His career allowed the family to get ahead and was the reason Brittany's mom became the first in her family to go to college and earn a degree.

EXPERIENCE



PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE

As an attorney in Los Angeles, Brittany has represented a broad range of clients, including business owners, domestic violence survivors, and refugees seeking asylum. She has also worked with a nonprofit to expand mental health services for teens.

PUBLIC SERVICE

Appointed by Mayor Karen Bass, Brittany was recently chosen to serve as President of L.A.'s Human Relations Commission, where she leads the fight against hate crimes. This is vital work in L.A., where, for more than a decade, hate crimes and harassment directed at Jewish, Black, Asian, and LGBTQ+ people have been on the rise. Recent figures from LA County, reported in December 2024, show that hate crimes had reached an all-time high: "Following three years of double-digit increases, reported hate crimes in Los Angeles County drastically increased 45% from 930 to 1,350, the largest number in the history of this report." Notably, Brittany has stated that because "hate crimes go largely underreported, the numbers give us only part of the picture." She is working on programs to defend individuals and communities that are targeted, expand public awareness on how to take action, increase reporting, and support victims.



VISION AND MISSION

There is no district in the state like the coastal Senate District 24, and Brittany's experience connects to all the regions within it. Throughout her career, she has used her capacity to build strong coalitions of people and organizations to address local issues and improve lives. Right now the community needs solutions that address wildfire response and rebuilding, housing that people who work here can afford, public safety, healthcare access, coastal protection, economic development, and boosting opportunities for small businesses and workers. The voters in this State Senate District are not looking for typical politicians. They're looking for problem solvers who bring people together—and Brittany McKinley's unique experience and approach will go a long way to create transformative change.


