SSLA YOUTH HIGH POINT AWARD

The SSLA Youth High Point Award was designed to allow the SSLA to recognize one youth exhibitor at each show supported by the SSLA in the southeast. The youth does not have to be an SSLA member. The award goes to one youth participating in all the youth classes: Obstacle, PR, Pack and Showmanship. The SSLA point chart is used to tabulate the points earned and the award will be given to the youth exhibitor with the most points. The show staff calculates the points, announces the winner and gives the award. Any SSLA Board member present at the show may wish to be with the show staff at the time the presentation is made. The award was initially a leather show halter and lead. When youth expressed a preference for money, it became a \$40 cash award.

Three to four weeks prior to each show, the SSLA Treasurer should send to each Show Superintendent the following:

- 1. A copy of the High Point Plan outline
- 2. A copy of the Points Tabulation Chart
- 3. An envelope with the award check and a letter from the SSLA congratulating the youth.
