Happy February, Brethren!

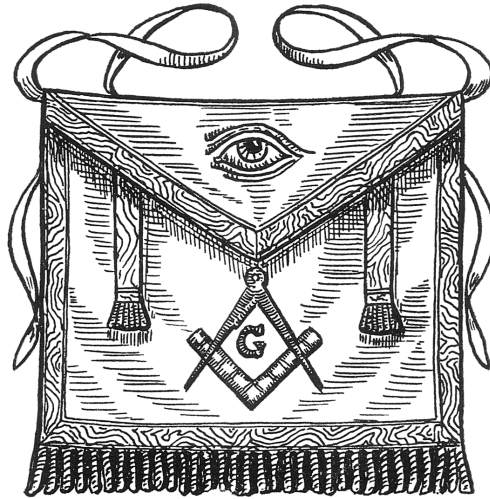

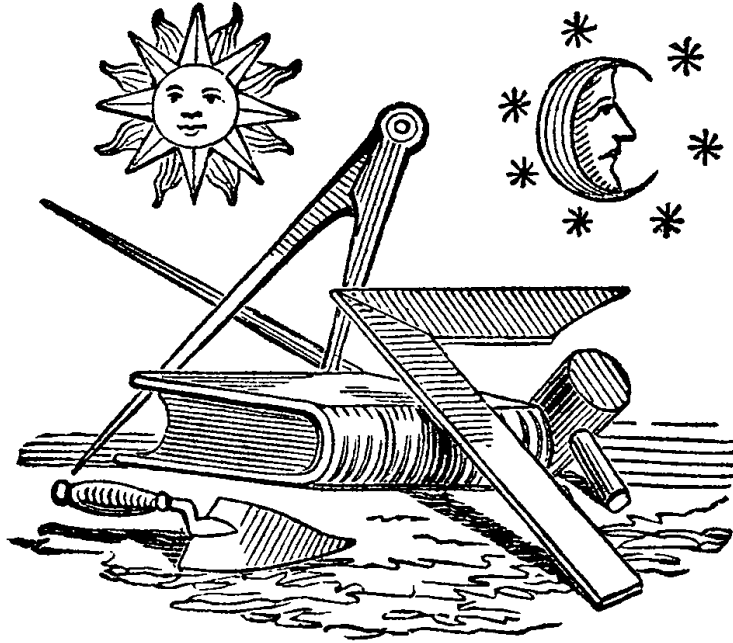

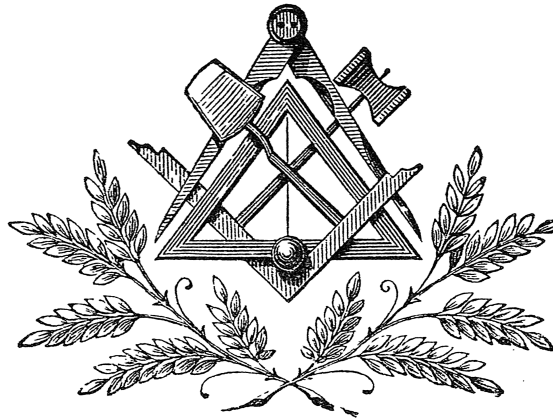
