Clinical Noting



The WebV Clinical Noting Module provides clinical staff a digitised method of creating and recording of all supporting notes and continuation notes attaining to the patients time in the hospital. Historically hand written notes that accompanied the patient records can now be input directly onto the system and can be shared, viewed, recalled and filtered by all authorised personnel for any role. The module can be accessed and used via a PC, tablet or mobile device. The module supports free key noting, attachments along with annotation to images.



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The Clinical Noting module allows users to record additional information relating to the patient that would be beneficial to other health care professionals. All notes are housed in one module, meaning that they are easy to locate and filters can be applied to search for specific entries in the record.

Clinical Noting	 Ability to create a new clinical note from within the clinical noting module. Creating a new clinical note requires users to select episode type, theme, clinical area and designation before writing the free text note. Once the clinical area and designation are completed on the first clinical note, this is auto populated on future clinical notes until amended by the user. All submitted clinical notes can be viewed in the patient's clinical noting record. Notes are displayed in reverse chronological order with the most recent showing at the top of the page. The content of the note, date and time of submission, author, episode type and theme are all visible on the page. Ability to reverse sort the order of clinical notes Clinical note entries can be filtered by a date range, episodes, themes, designations and clinical areas Clinical note entries can be marked as erroneous. Suppressed notes still display within the module but are struck through Designation and clinical area for the note are visible within the clinical note details For clinical notes with the theme of Ward Round, requirement to also record who the ward round is led by. Ability to record a clinical note against a timeline event On clicking on a clinical note event, full details are displayed
