Section 1

Think about this:

1. Is there an “unknown” in your life right now where God is asking for your obedience before He reveals the full map or plan? Explain.

2. Hebrews 11:9 states that Abraham and his family lived in tents as he sought the eternal foundations of God. How much of your peace is connected to your temporary “tents” (possessions, status, comfort) versus your eternal home?

3. If God called you to move as Abraham did, what is one “baggage item” from your past or comfort zone that you’d need to leave in “Ur” to fully step into what God has for you in “Canaan”?

Section 2

Think about this:

1. Have you ever ‘laughed’ at a dream or spiritual call because you felt you were past your prime or too far gone? Explain. How can Sarah’s story change your view of God’s timing and power?

2. Sarah saw God as faithful and was made fertile. When you face a huge obstacle, do you focus more on the **size of the problem** or on the **character of the Promise-Maker**?

3. God did something for Sarah that she couldn’t do on her own. Is there an area in your life - such as a relationship, ministry, or habit - where you need God-given strength to bring new life into it?

Section 3

Think about this:

1. Isaac blessed his sons for their future. Are your prayers and actions focused only on your current needs, or are you actively planting seeds of faith for the generations to come?

2. Isaac’s blessing for his boys didn’t go as he originally planned. Where is God asking you to let go of “your plan” and trust His future instead?
