A Journey through the *Spiritual Hall of Fame* Hebrews 11 - Part 5

Section 1

Think about this:

1. The Israelites had to take that first step before the sea parted. Is God asking you to “wet your feet” by taking a step of obedience before He reveals the path through your current obstacle?

2. At Jericho, the walls didn’t fall until after the seventh day of “pointless” marching. Are you tempted to give up on a prayer or promise because you haven’t seen the “walls” move yet? What do you learn from the Jericho story?

3. In these verses, the Hall of Famer is a collective “They.” How does the faith (or doubt) of the people around you influence your ability to see God’s power in your life? Do you need to make any changes in your relationships?

Section 2

Think about this:

1. Rahab had to choose between the familiar city and people she knew and the God she had only heard about. Is there a “worldly city” or lifestyle you're holding on to that’s preventing you from fully aligning with God’s kingdom?

2. Rahab only heard about the parting of the Red Sea; she never experienced it firsthand. Still, she believed. (Romans 10:17 says, “Faith comes from hearing.”) Is there someone you know who has not heard the message of Jesus that you can share with? Pray for the opportunity to do so.

3. Rahab placed a scarlet cord in her window as a sign of her faith and a plea for mercy. (Joshua 2:18, 21) The cord became her protection. What is the “Sign” in your life that shows you are trusting in God’s grace rather than your own efforts?
