There are two scholarship opportunities available. Applicants can only apply for *ONE*. Carefully review the stipulations for each scholarship opportunity. Identify your choice of the two scholarships. The amount of each scholarship is dependent upon available funds.

_____ **NCNW EDUCATIONAL INCENTIVE:** Applicant must be an African American senior currently enrolled in one of the following Pinellas County schools: Boca Ciega H.S., Hollins H.S, Gibbs H.S., Lakewood H.S., Northeast H.S., and St. Petersburg H.S. Applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or above to be eligible for this award and may attend any college or university in or out of state. This scholarship award is for one academic year only.

_____ **RALPH W. YOUNG FAMILY FOUNDATION:** Applicant must be an African American senior currently enrolled in one of the following Pinellas County schools: Boca Ciega H.S., Hollins H.S, Gibbs H.S., Lakewood H.S., Northeast H.S., and St. Petersburg H.S. Applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or above to be eligible for this award, and may attend any Historically Black College or University (HBCU) or any public four-year college or university in the state of Florida.

This scholarship may be continued for eight semesters (excluding summer semester) if the following conditions are met: must be enrolled full-time (12 or more credits) each fall and spring semesters, a total of thirty credit hours per year (summer credits are included), and a cumulative 3.0 grade point average. The amount of funding may be adjusted due to other factors beyond the control of Ralph W. Young Family Foundation.
