# From the Executive Director


Dear friend,





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WSR hosted six in-person 30-hour MentorMe! programs with a total of 115 participants. 25 of those participants completed the rigorous certification process. To support our equity goals, we carefully examined how to extend our reach. WSR will continue to offer them mentoring and support as they begin serving their communities.





# **On-Going Mentoring/Support**

# **Monday Night Group Coaching**

In 2024, WSR hosted 44 calls averaging 16 people per call. Trainees can go into breakout rooms with the two coaches which results in 88 hours of 1:1 mentoring. On the main page, group coaching happens for both trainees and the parents by WSR Trainers like Megan Rader, Allen Park teacher.

## Tools in 10!

Each Monday night calls starts with a ten minute training. We call it Tools in 10! In 2024, 19 new, professionally edited videos were created. They are made open to the public and posted on We Shall Read's YouTube Channel for world-wide access.



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Erin Hardin is the WSR MentorMe! Program Director which includes training new WSR mentors. She also hosts the Toolsin10! video series and typically leads the Monday night group coaching calls. Erin also is a lead facilitator for MentorMe! training programs. Here she is supporting Cornerstone Charter School in screening their students at the beginning of the year. In her free time, she runs her own tutoring business.

## Make and Take!

Four times a year, trainees and parents pay a small fee to join in the fun making extension materials for implementing the BFR program for a fraction of the actual cost. The goal is to assist people in learning more about how to implement the BFR program while prepping materials.









# **New Lead Facilitators**










# **Grant Dollars at Work**


