Gentlemen:

Have you ever noticed any missing notes on either the violin or piano of your VIOLANO-VIRTUOSO ?

Probably you never have, as this is an infrequent occurrence; but because of its importance we thought it best to mention it to you, as it is really very easy to correct.

The cause of missing notes is generally due to the feeder contact brushes being out of adjustment. These brushes being the very nerve center of the Violano require attention at certain intervals, and we recommend that you check them today, and about once every second month hereafter; following the instructions attached hereto.

It is a simple matter to adjust them to the proper length, and thirty minutes of your time may save an expensive visit of one of our servicemen at a later date.

We believe you want to know more about your instrument - we want you to - it is very simple, and we know you will receive a great amount of satisfaction in knowing how to take care of the instrument yourself.
