- 1. Trip to China Town-Either Carpool or take the train to Downtown China Town. Have brunch at a Dim Sum restaurant. Let the kids have 1 hour in town to explore and shop by themselves why the moms do too. Best to do in the winter just prior to Chinese New Year.
