ADDITIONAL INFORMATION AND REGISTRATION FORM

- 1) Students must be registered (PAID IN FULL) to participate in any class and registration is ongoing. Fill in the form completely with your payment and mail it or drop it off at the recreation department. ***Another option is to place your registration form and check or money order (NO CASH) into an envelope and place it in the dropbox located in the lobby at Harper Woods City Hall that is open 24 hours. There is no payment plan available for the summer session. Sorry, phone registrations aren't available. Cash, checks, or money orders are accepted if you register at the recreation office.
- **2) We encourage families to stay and watch the dance classes.** It might be a good idea to bring your own chair or blanket. We do ask everyone to keep the noise levels to a minimum so that students can concentrate. It can become difficult for the students to hear their dance instructor and music if there are distractions. Thanks for your support and cooperation.
- **3) INFORMATION ABOUT SHOES**---There is no need to purchase any ballet slippers or other dance shoes since they will be dancing on concrete.
- **4) INFORMATION ABOUT DANCE ATTIRE**---We recommend students wear any type of dancewear or comfortable clothes they can easily move around in.
